The Cumberland Area Senior Center is a 5013C non-profit organization serving people over the age of 50.

Membership is \$15/yr. All programming and activities are led by volunteers. In the past, the center had many more members and a paid part-time activity director. Over the years, membership has decreased. The interior of the center has not been upgraded in a very long time.

The building has great potential-one level, spacious, with an industrial kitchen (where the ADRC prepares meals for the Meals on Wheels program).

The Center hosts card games, dominoes, BINGO, bridge, and coffee times. Recently a coffee station was added so members can drop in and have coffee with friends or make new friends. This could be a dynamic place for additional programs and opportunities for those over 50 in our area.

Our senior citizens should have a welcoming, comfortable, beautifully maintained space. With more ability to reach area citizens and an improved environment, the Cumberland Area Senior Center could become another jewel in the crown of Cumberland.
